Membership will run for 12 months from 1st April. Fees are due on 15th March. For anyone joining during the course of the membership year, the fee will be charged pro rata to the end of March (for details refer to www.silverarrowarchery.co.uk).

Applicants agree to be bound by the provisions of the company's articles of association, its rules and by-laws, in particular to guarantee the debts of the company up to a maximum amount of £1 if the company is wound up while a member and for a period of up to 12 months after membership ends.

Junior Members

A Junior member is defined as a person who is 10 years of age and above but younger than 18 years of age, or who is under the age of 21 and in full time education.

Silver Arrow Archery Club takes no responsibility for unaccompanied juniors, who may be turned away and refused shooting rights if not accompanied appropriately.
