Silver Arrow Archery Club membership categories:-

Full Senior member -	Inclusive membership for indoor and outdoor archery
Associate Senior member -	For outdoor archery and payment of a fee for indoor archery
Full Junior member -	Inclusive membership for indoor and outdoor archery
Associate Junior member-	For outdoor archery and payment of a fee for indoor archery

A Junior member is defined as a person who is 10 years of age and above but younger than 18 years of age, or who is under the age of 21 and in full time education.

Membership will run for 12 months from 1st April. Fees are due on 15th March. For anyone joining during the course of the membership year, the fee will be charged pro rata to the end of March.

Associate member indoor monthly shooting fees are **£15.00 per month** payable in advance.

If you wish to become a member of Archery GB then you can join through **Silver Arrow Archers** (contact secretary@silverarrowarchers.co.uk). Joining through Silver Arrow Archers will offer you a saving against joining direct. You will still need to be a member of Silver Arrow Archery Club but there is no extra fee for joining Silver Arrow Archers.
